




This week has been art week!

Make a recycling poster for your classroom.




















A Message for Year 6 Families

This half term the children have started to use Learning by Questions. This is an online tool that supports teaching them to their gaps in understanding across reading, maths and grammar and punctuation. It is as effective as a personal AI tutor!

The children enjoy using it in school and over the holidays we will be asking that they spend as much time as possible on their independent study.

After half term, we have made a weekly plan for all children in Year 6:

Week 1- Monday 28th April—Friday 2nd May: Year 6 children invited in to school from 8am to a booster session every morning on learning by questions. They should come through the front oflice.

Week 2- (Monday 5th May– School closed) Tuesday 6th– Friday 9th May: Year 6 children invited in to school from 8am to a booster session every morning on learning by questions. They should come through the front office.

On Tuesday 6th, if your child is signed up to go on the residential, then there is a parent/carer meeting about this.

Week 3 – SATS week – Monday 12th May – Thursday 15th May: Year 6 children invited in to school from 8am to have a SATs breakfast. All children must be in school on these dates.

Friday 16th May: As long as all children are in school for Week 3 then this will mark the end of SATS week. A non uniform day for Year 6 children only will be confirmed on Thursday 15th by 3:15pm.

Week 4– School returns to normal time. 8:30am classroom doors. We will still be doing our writing lessons and we will be blocking full afternoons of our foundation subjects.


