We have a new Family Support Worker, Miss Beck- she'll be outside on the gates welcoming you all in next week!




When dismissed at the end of the day, either when pupils are collected, or if parents have given permission for children to walk home alone, all children must **walk** off of school site.

PSHE Learning

This half term in PSHE, Years 1 – 6 will be exploring 'Safety and the Changing Body'. In this unit, children will learn how to keep themselves safe; whether that be online or out and about, and some of the changes that will happen to their bodies as they grow older. Please take a look at your child's year group to find out what they will be learning and some of the vocabulary we will be using with them. All lessons in Years 1-5 are statutory and parents do not have the right to withdraw their children from lessons. These lessons cover the statutory requirements outlined by the government and have been carefully planned to be age appropriate.

In Year 6, the government recommends children learn about some key areas of sex education before they leave primary school. We have chosen to teach these non-statutory lessons and these have been highlighted clearly on the curriculum outline. These have been planned and will be delivered in an age-appropriate way, however, should you wish to withdraw your child from these lessons please speak to either Mr. Auld or Mrs. Williams <u>before Friday</u> <u>24th May 2024.</u>

As part of this unit, we will also be using the NSPCC 'Talk PANTS' resources. These resources help children to understand that their body belongs to them and keeping themselves safe.
