The children will be reflecting on this in class and you may want to talk about this at home!








We have had the best time learning all about the Coronation.


Here are some photos from our Nursery this morning where the children made their own crowns— we think they look amazing.

Not sure if your child should have a hearing test?

Below are just a few of the signs that a child may be struggling with their hearing:

- They do not reply when you call them
- They talk very loudly
- They ask you to repeat yourself a lot or respond differently / inappropriately to what you have
- They increase the volume on TV/devices etc.
- They appear to daydream a lot
- They get frustrated/aggressive frequently They are slow to learn to talk/unclear when talking
