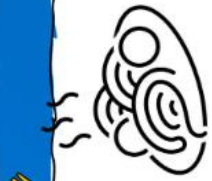

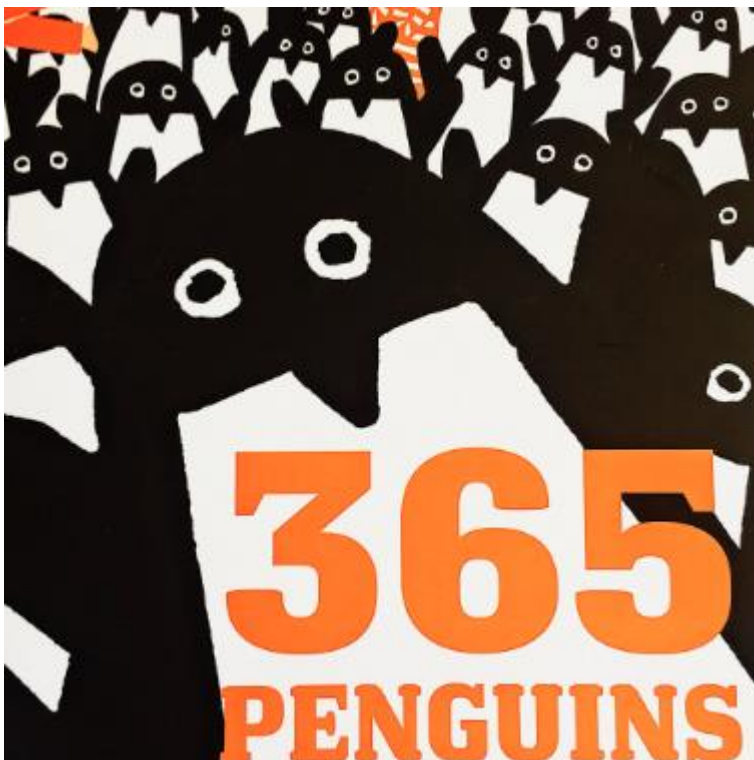
National Story Telling Week- Pjama Day Monday 29th January
