Each week staff nominate someone (or occasionally, a few people) who have gone over and above for our Gosford Park Community.

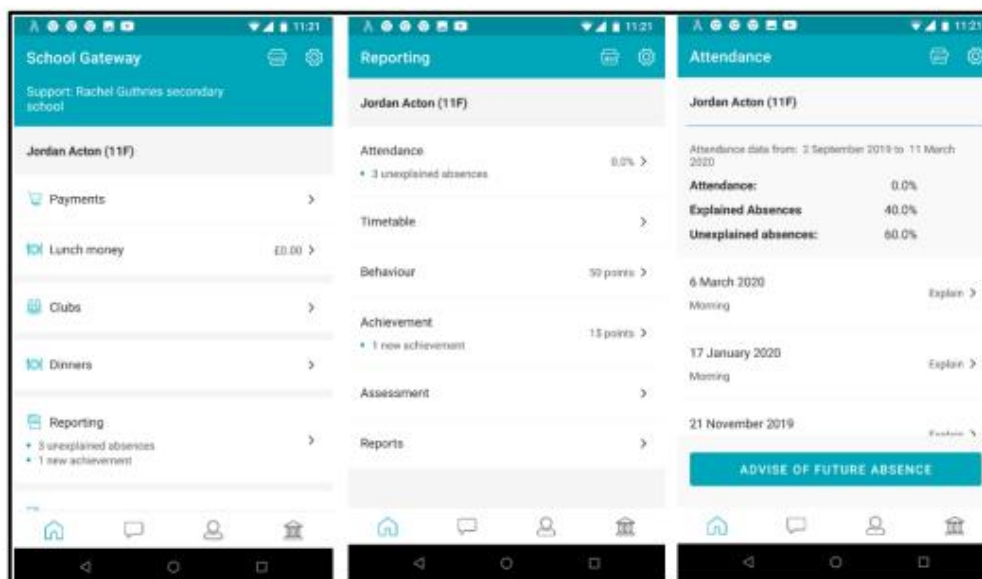

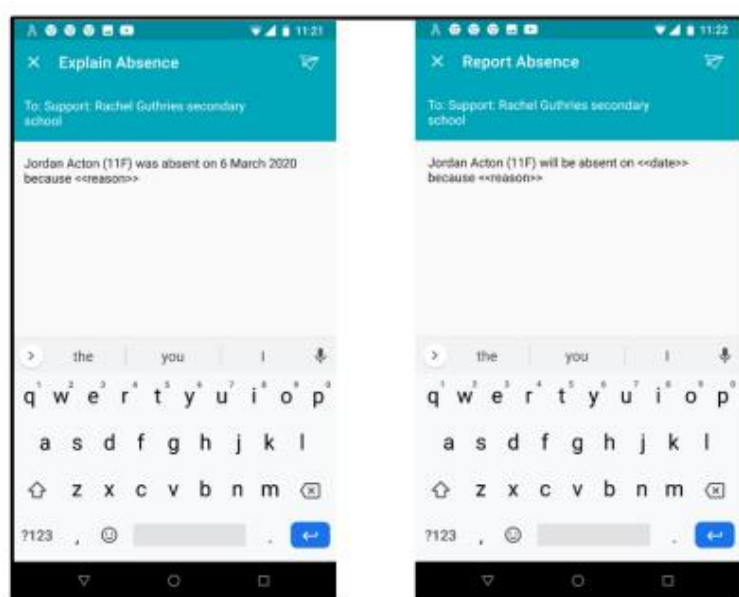


## Reporting an absence on Schoolcomms

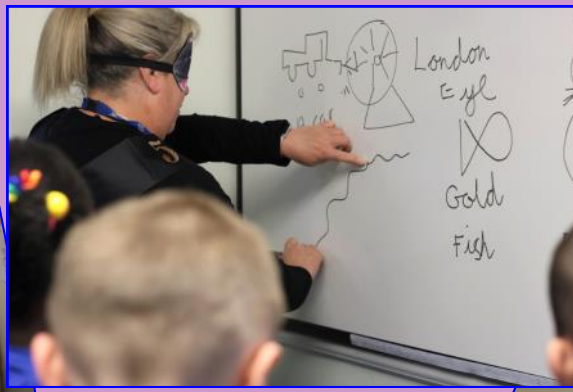
