Measles Vaccination at Gosford Park

There have been an increasing number of confirmed measles cases in the West Midlands, including in Coventry. The NHS, Public Health and Education have been working together to reduce the spread of measles and have designed an enhanced pop-up vaccination programme focussed on school communities.

Gosford Park has been offered the opportunity to be one of the first to benefit from these dedicated vaccination sessions.

The MMR vaccine is a safe and effective way of protecting against measles. Two doses of the vaccine provide the best protection.

The session held at the school will be open to all children who attend the school, their siblings and any close family members they live with. You are eligible if you have not had 2 doses of the MMR vaccine.

It is strongly recommended that everyone check their own and their family's vaccination status in readiness for the catch-up sessions. Your GP surgery should be able to check whether you've had both doses of the MMR vaccine. You may also be able to access your vaccination record online through GP online services.

If your vaccination records are not available, or do not exist, it will not harm you to have the MMR vaccine again.

The vaccination session for Gosford Park will take place on 6th March 9:00-12:30pm.

Further details including consent forms will be sent to all parents in the next few days.
