A Typical Day in Year 1

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- ▶ Busy Learning
- ▶ Autumn 1 – throughout the day
- ▶ Autumn 2 – less in the morning, still in the afternoon
- ▶ Spring 1 – more formal morning and Busy Learning some afternoons
- ▶ Spring 2 – formal morning and more formal afternoon
- ▶ The Year One classroom will continue to reflect learning and layout children have been familiar with in Reception. It will reflect the National Curriculum areas of learning.
- ▶ Learning Takes place inside the classroom and in the outdoor classroom

Year 1 National Curriculum

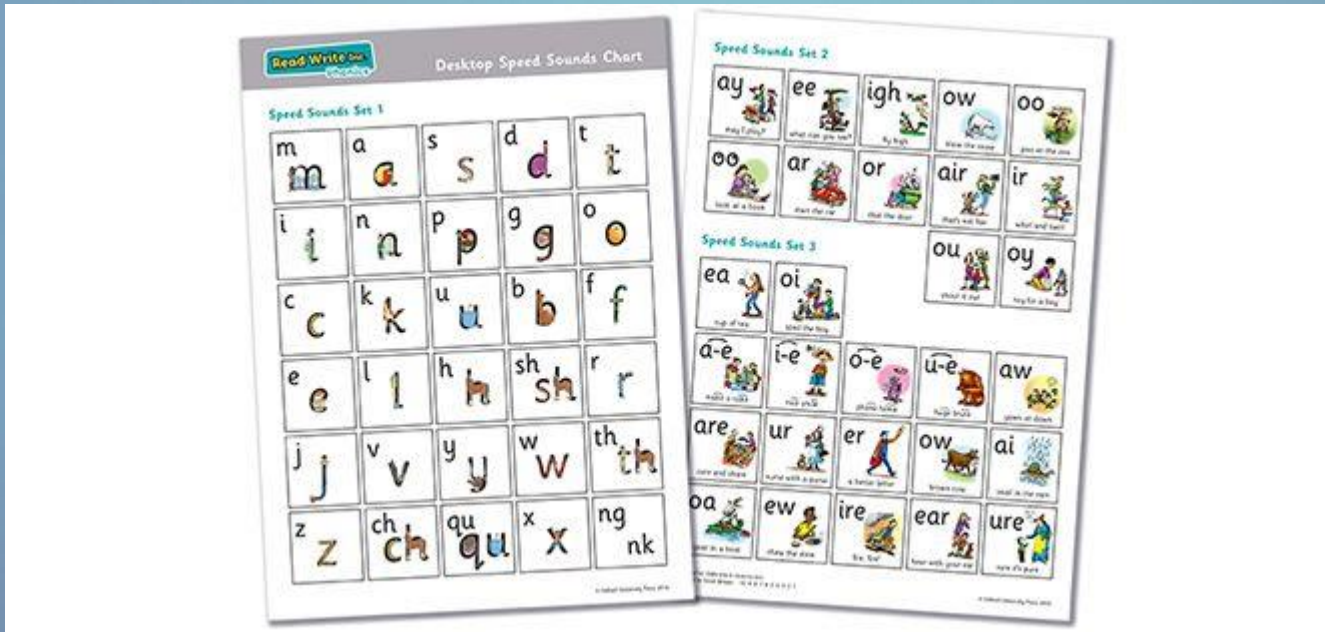
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- ▶ Year one follows the National Curriculum
- ▶ Core Subjects include:
 - ▶ English
 - ▶ Maths
 - ▶ Science
- ▶ Foundation Subjects
 - ▶ Art & Design
 - ▶ Design & Technology
 - ▶ Geography
 - ▶ History
 - ▶ Computing
 - ▶ Music
 - ▶ Physical education

Phonics

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- ▶ Children will continue to build-on their phonic knowledge.
- ▶ RWI taught 30 mins 5xs a week
- ▶ Phonics screening June 2024
- ▶ phonics folders with a new sheet sent home (return back to school every day)



Topic Work

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- ▶ Autumn 1 - **Toys**
- ▶ Autumn 2 - **UK**
- ▶ Spring 1 - **Florence Nightingale**
- ▶ Spring 2 - **Mary Anning**
 - ▶ museum
- ▶ Summer 1 – **Local Study – Local area**
 - ▶ Walk around local area
- ▶ Summer 2 – **Local Study – Bicycles/Cars**
 - ▶ Coventry Transport Museum

Homework

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- ▶ Read for at least 10 mins each night to an adult
- ▶ Homework books - once a week given out one week and due the next week.
- ▶ Half Term homework given before each holiday
- ▶ Weekly spelling
- ▶ Phonics book or sheet - practise a little each day
- ▶ Check class Dojo for

Homework should be fun so pick a time to complete when appropriate for your child.

Uniform

- ▶ School uniform gives children a sense of belonging and pride
- ▶ Uniform consists of:
 - ▶ Grey or black trousers or skirt
 - ▶ White Polo shirt
 - ▶ Black shoes
 - ▶ Royal blue jumper or cardigan
 - ▶ Blue gingham dress (summer), grey pinafore

- ▶ Label all uniform
- ▶ Limit accessories as these become problematic





Physical Education


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- ▶ Uniform – available from Andy Blair
 - ▶ Black, navy or grey shorts or joggers
 - ▶ Royal blue t-shirt
 - ▶ Trainers
 - ▶ Royal blue jumper, hoodie or fleece
- ▶ For safety reasons, children are not permitted to wear jewelry in school. Stud earrings are permitted but must be covered for PE.
- ▶ 2 sessions each week, days TBC

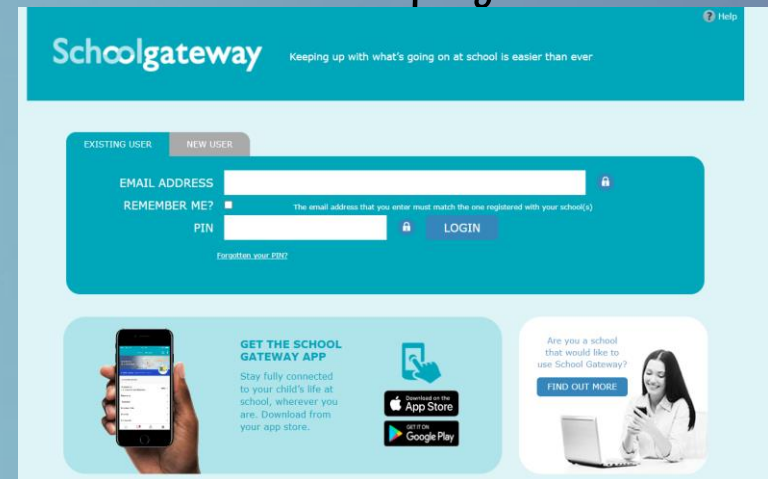
